
FIRE FIGHTER CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY

Policy #3

Date: January 16, 2015

Purpose

It is intended that the Dress Uniform will be worn at those functions related to the Fire Department, other than practices and call-outs, and/or other public or private functions where its display will bring acknowledgement to the role of the Fire Department in the community. It is expected that the Firefighter will generally determine which functions to which he/she will wear the uniform; any issues regarding the application of this policy will be decided by the SIFPS Board of Directors.

Policy

The following shall apply regarding the conduct of Firefighters while wearing the Fire Department's Dress Uniform:

- 1) The firefighter shall, at all times, conduct himself/herself in a manner that will not negatively reflect upon the Fire Department when his/her action(s) are viewed by a reasonable person.
- 2) Specifically regarding the consumption of alcohol, and in addition to 1. foregoing – the firefighter will at all times conduct himself/herself in a manner that would legally allow him/her to drive a private vehicle on public roads.

This policy does not apply to the wearing of Turn-Out Gear.

The policy of no alcohol on site at ESB#1 and/or ESB#2 shall continue.
