POLICY #20 DRIVERS LICENSING

Approved: October 3, 2024

Policy

This policy clarifies the ICBC insurance requirements for any driver responding to a medical dispatch call.

- In order to respond to any call in "ambulances" Car 1 and/or Car 2, drivers must hold a valid Class 1, 2 or 4 driver's license. This includes driving the SIR emergency vehicles with or without a patient in transport while responding to a call.
- In the instance that a patient must be transported in a Fire Department vehicle the driver must hold a Class 1, 2 or 4 driver's license only when a patient is in the vehicle and transportation in the vehicle has been authorized by BCEHS approved Medical Oversight or BCEHS approved dispatch.
